




# 3.INSTALLATION PROCEDURE

### 3.1 Installation Method for Helmet Applications




 Loosen the screws on the back of universal helmet clamp with the provided screw driver






Insert the pin header of the corresponding clamp of Bluetooth device (as shown in figure) and make sure the device is installed properly and firmly



Open the lining of helmet (at ear's position), clean the EPS surface and affix the VELCRO on with the rough surface







6 Insert the headphone plug into the corresponding headphone jack on the back of clamp to finish the installation

Fix the mini microphone on the collar near mouth with the microphone clamp



# 7.FUNCTIONS AND OPERATION OF BUTTONS

### 7.1 On/Off button and Intercom button



- 7. 1. 1 On
- 7. 1. 2 Off
- 7. 1. 3 Start the Bluetooth Intercom
- 7. 1. 4 End the Bluetooth Intercom
- 7. 1. 5 Switch between Intercom and Music
- 7. 1. 6 Clear the pairing record

7. 1. 1	Press down for 3 seconds until hear "Welcome to use FreedConn product" voice prompt. The blue light will flash 3 times swiftly and then turn into regular flashing.
7. 1. 2	Press down for 5 seconds until hear "Power off" voice prompt. The red light will be on for a while and then die out.
7. 1. 3	Shortly press the button on either one of the two paired T-Rexes and a voice prompt will be heard after completing the intercom connection.
7. 1. 4	Shortly press the button and intercom closes after a "bee" prompt tone.
7. 1. 5	Shortly press the button and a "bee" prompt tone can be heard.
7. 1. 6	When pressing down the button to start the device, hold the button down for another 3 seconds after the red light flashes until the red light quickly flashes 3 times and a "toot" prompt tone can be heard, which means clearing is successful and the device is started.

(Pressing down for 5 seconds when shutting down the device does not clear record) Note: the clearing will clear all memories; Press down for 8 seconds to enter pairing status if pairing record is not cleared and press down for 5 seconds to automatically enter pairing status if pairing record is cleared.





  - Turn the knob counter clockwise and hold it to decrease volume until it reaches the level you want. A "toot" prompt will also be heard when it reaches Min volume.




9.1 Pairing with Mobile Phone, Mp3 and GPS



- Step 1: Ensure T-Rex is off and within 1 m visible range of the device to be paired.
- **Step 2:** Press down the T-Rex On/Off button/Intercom button for 8 seconds until you hear "Pairing" prompt, when the red light and blue light flash alternatively, T-Rex enters pairing status.
- **Step 3:** Start the Bluetooth device to be paired, search and choose T-Rex to pair.

  When you hear "Your phone is connected" prompt and the blue light flashes regularly, pairing is successful.


### 9.2 Pairing with (FreedConn) L2 Adaptor



L2 (Bluetooth Adaptor)

- Step 1: Ensure T-Rex is off and within 1 m visible range of the device to be paired.
- Step 2: Press down the T-Rex On/Off buton/Intercom button for 8 seconds until you hear "Pairing" prompt, when the red light and blue light flash alternatively, T-Rex enters pairing status.
- Step 3:Press down the On/Off button of L2 adaptor for 6 seconds to enter pairing status and automatically search for pairing. Pairing is successful when the indicator lights of T-Rex and L2 all flash blue regularly.

### 9. 3 Matching with (FreedConn) L3 Remote Control




Step 1: (Operations on receiving end of T-Rex): When T-Rex is on, press the On/Off button of T-Rex 3 times quickly to switch it into matching mode, and the red indicator light keeps on and blue indicator light flashes under such mode.

Note: T-Rex matching mode will only last for 1 minute. If matching is not successful in this minute, the matching mode will be turned off and red light will go off.

Step 2: (Operations on the emitting end of remote control): First press and hold the multi-functional button of remote control, then press and hold the signal button. When you see the green indicator light of remote control flashes 3 times quickly, let go of the two buttons. T-Rex's red indicator light will go off, indicating matching is successful.

# 9.4 Pairing between Two T-Rexes



Step 1: Ensure both T-Rex are off and within 1 m visible range of each other.

Step 2: Press down both T-Rex On/Off button /Intercom button for 8 seconds until you hear "Pairing" prompt from both T-Rexes, when the red light and blue light flash alternatively, both T-Rexes enter pairing status.

**Note:** If you cannot enter the status of red/blue light flashing alternately, please clear the matching operation record, then repeat the aforementioned steps.

Step 3: Quickly press the On/Off button on either T-Rex. Then it will search for the other T-Rex for pairing. When the blue light flashes regularly it means pairing is successful.

### 9.5 Group Intercom Settings (Take a group of 6 people as example)



**Note:** The frontmost and backmost cyclers (shown as A and F in figure) are not allowed to be paired.



### Step 1: Clear the matching record between A and F

Press and hold the On/Off buttons of A and F for 8 s until you hear prompt tone "Power off", then hold them for another  $3 \, \text{s}$ .

### Step 2: Refer to the matching operations in 9.4 for following operations

- Step 2.1 Match A with B, and turn off B after match is completed (Note: Just turn it off. Do not clear the matching record);
- Step 2.2 Match B and C, and turn C off after match is completed;
- Step 2.3 Match C and D, and turn D off after match is completed;
- Step 2.4 Match D and E, and turn E off after match is completed;
- Step 2.5 Match E and F.

(At this moment, A, B, C, D, E and F are all turned on).

### Step 3: Connect A, B, C, D, E and F in series.

Step 3.1 For D, press the On/Off button to connect with E;

Step 3.2 For C, press the On/Off button to connect with D;

Step 3.3 For B, press the On/Off button to connect with C;

Step 3.4 For A, press the On/Off button to connect with B.


(Now A, B, C, D, E and F are all matched successfully, you can enter group talk)

# 9.6 Operations Mode for Cases When Someone Receives a Call during Group Intercom

During 6 people group intercom, if C receives a call, he or she will be disconnected from other group members (A pairs with B to form a group, C forms its own group, D, E and F form a group).









After C's call is over, he or she will be automatically reconnected into the group intercom and the 6 people group intercom resumes.

### 9.7 Connecting with Multiple Devices

The group members can connect to multiple devices (mobile phones, GPS and adaptors) when connecting with the group



Frontmost and backmost members of the group (A and F) can connect with any two devices of mobile phones, GPS or adaptors apart from connecting with one group member.



Members in the middle of group (B, C, D, E) can connect with any one device of mobile GPS or adaptors apart from connecting with 2 group members.

# 10. PRIORITY OF FUNCTIONS

Level 1: Phone Call / Two-way radio audio introduced by adaptor

Level 2: Bluetooth Intercom Level 3: Music / FM radio

### Analysis:

- 1. During a call, two-way radio intercom / Bluetooth intercom / music / FM radio are all not operable. But there will be a prompt tone upon the coming of two-way radio intercom invitation and Bluetooth intercom invitation .
- During an two-way radio intercom, Bluetooth intercom, music and FM radio are all not operable. But there will be a prompt tone upon the coming of Bluetooth intercom.
   During Bluetooth intercom, music and FM radio are not operable.

(Intercom introduced by two-way radio control cable will not be affected by priority. It can be carried out simultaneously with call, music and FM radio.)

Polymer Batteries are used in this product, so please put it in dry places. Recharge the battery after more than 1 month of storage to achieve the service life of product.

- 1. If the battery volume is full, the blue light will flash one time every 2 seconds when the device is on.
- 2. Alarm will be intrigued when the battery is running low. Alarm will be prompted every 60 seconds (the voice of prompt is "Battery low" and red light flashes every 60 seconds). Continual use will lead to auto-shutdown.
- 3. Red light will be on during recharging and die out when the battery is full.
- 4. The product is available for use during charging.
